Transportation to and from Fort Meade Child, Youth and School Services Program is available at 7 Anne Arundel County schools: Manor View Elementary, Pershing Hill Elementary, West Meade Early Education Center, Seven Oaks Elementary (Not on Installation), Meade Heights Elementary, MacArthur Middle School and Meade Middle School. Please note: All off post districts and or school assignments are designated by the selected residential address. Each district has an internal transfer process and the internal transfer must be approved on an annual basis. School district transfers (County to County) are only granted

SCHOOL REGISTRATION:

At what age can my child start school?

For all Maryland counties, children must be five 3. years old on or before September 1st of the year 4. he/she is presented for enrollment to be eligible to 5. register for public schools.

What is required for enrollment?

- 1. Birth Certificate
- 2. Current Shot Record
- Social Security Number
- 4. Copy of the child's physical exam
- Two Proofs of Parent/Custodian residence (lease, mortgage, utility bill)
- 6. Custody or guardian papers filed through the court. (if applicable)

How do I enroll for school?

You can locate your school via the school website. You can call and make an appointment or just go to the school to register. Please contact the School Liaison for Q&A

SCHOOL CHOICE OPTIONS:

- Public School Choice: Three public school districts border Fort Meade: Anne Arundel, Howard and Prince Georges, all have public school options and several magnet school programs to include: International Baccalaureate Diploma, Middle Years and Primary Years and Homeland Security Signature program specifically at Meade area schools.
