SHABACH Emergency Empowerment Center

The Emergency Empowerment Center is an emergency food and clothing bank located in Landover, MD. On average, the Empowerment Center serves roughly 15 families a week who are seeking food support for their household. It is their goal to provide each individual that crosses their threshold, in need, with at least 6 bags of food, which is enough to support a family of 4-6 for at least 3 weeks. In addition to the daily services they also partner with other local non profit organizations and schools for events like their quarterly 1500 grocery bag give-a-way, Thanksgiving baskets, and weekend food packages for hungry children. Additionally, they provide job readiness classes and resources for individuals who are either unemployed or underemployed.
