Pre-Deployment /Reintegration Brief

Learn about creating or updating essential legal documents, organizing your finances, creating a family care plan and designing a contingency plan in case things change. The resources in this brief can help you and your family prepare, get organized and navigate challenges upon return.

Care Team

This training is critical prior to starting a Care Team. The Care Team fills the gap between the notification team and the arrival of Family support.

Soldier and Family Readiness Groups

Soldier and Family Readiness Groups (SFRG) are command-sponsored programs; helping to build strong Families and bridge the gap between Families and units. SFRG training includes the following classes: SFRG Coordinator, Informal funds Custodian/alternate, Key Contact and Command Family Readiness Representative.

Provides relevant information regarding the Family Care Plan Checklist and aids in reviewing completed packets.
