BEGINNING PHOTOGRAPHY (1.5 hours)

You will learn how to use the creative automatic modes on your camera. By the end of the class, you will understand what each automatic mode will do to your photograph so you can choose the right creative mode for any situation.

INTERMEDIATE PHOTOGRAPHY (2 hours)

Are you still setting your camera to "Auto"? Take control of your camera and learn how to properly use your digital SLR camera in manual modes. By the end of the class, you will understand the relationship between f-stop, shutter speed, and ISO; know when to use aperture priority and shutter priority; use f-stop to creatively control focus; set ISO for various light conditions; and basic composition techniques. Homework assignments between class sessions.
